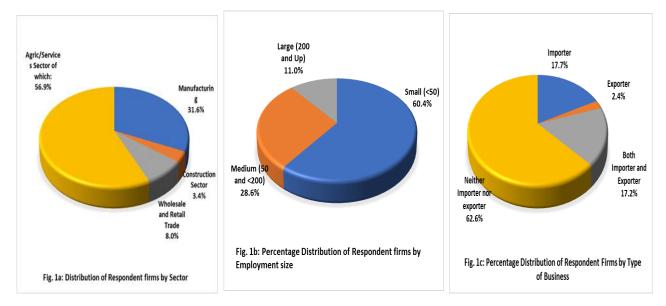
#### 1.0 Highlights

#### The highlights of the August 2020 survey outcome:

- Respondent firms expressed optimism on the macro economy.
- Respondents' outlook on average capacity utilization, volume of total order and financial conditions (working capital) remained positive while their outlook on access to credit was negative.
- Firms identified insufficient power supply, competition, high interest rates, unfavourable economic climate, financial problems, unclear economic laws, unfavourable political climate, insufficient demand, access to credit and lack of equipment as major factors constraining business activity.
- Respondent firms expect the Naira to depreciate in the current month but appreciate in the next month, next 2 months and next 6 months. Inflation level is expected to fall in the next 6 and 12 months, while borrowing rate is expected to rise in the current month, next month, next 2 months and next 6 months.

#### 2.0 Introduction

The August 2020 Business Expectations Survey was conducted August 13-20, 2020 with a sample size of 1050 businesses nationwide. A response rate of 93.9 per cent was achieved, and the sample covered the agric./services<sup>1</sup>, manufacturing, wholesale/retail trade and construction sectors (Fig. 1a, Table 1). The respondent firms were made up of small, medium and large corporations covering both importoriented and export-oriented businesses (Figs. 1b and 1c, Table 1).



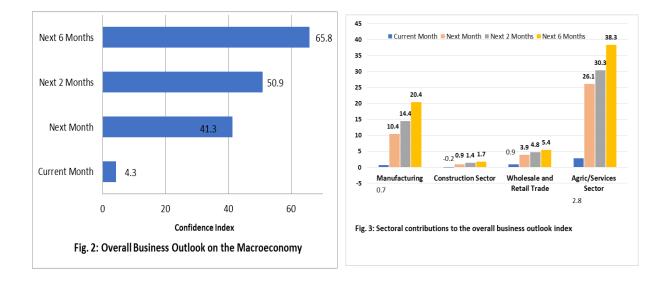

#### 3.0 Business Outlook

At 4.3 index points, the overall confidence index (CI) indicated respondents' optimism on the overall macro economy in the month of August. Respondents are also optimistic in their outlook for September with a confidence index of 41.3. Furthermore, they expressed optimism in the overall business outlook in October 2020 and February 2021 as shown in a greater confidence of the economy at 50.9 and 65.8 index points, respectively (Fig.2).

The optimism on the macro economy in August was driven by the opinion of respondents from agric./services (2.8 points), wholesale/retail trade (0.9 point), manufacturing (0.7 point). The major drivers of optimism for next month were agric/services (26.1 points), manufacturing (10.4 points), wholesale/Retail (3.9 points) and construction sectors (0.9 point) (Fig. 3, Table 1).

Further analysis showed that businesses that are neither import nor export-oriented (2.2 points), import-oriented (1.4 points), and export-oriented (0.9 point), drove the positive business outlook in August 2020.

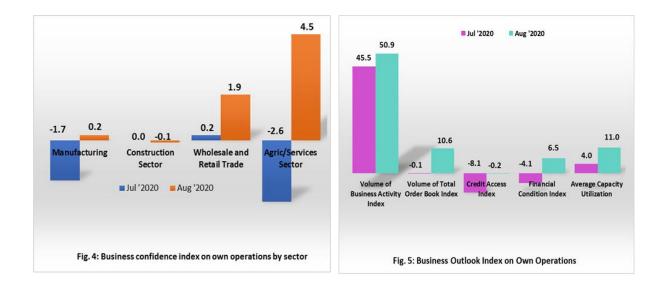


### 3.1 Business Confidence on Own Operations by Sector

Respondents expressed different opinions on own operations in the review month. While respondents from the agric./services, manufacturing and wholesale/retail sectors expressed optimism, those respondents from the construction sector expressed pessimism. Responses from agric/services, wholesale/retail and manufacturing had 4.5, 1.9 and 0.2 index points, respectively, while the responses from the construction sector had -0.1 point (Fig 4, Table 1).

### 3.2 Financial Conditions, Access to Credit and Installed Capacity

Respondents' outlook on average capacity utilization, volume of total order and financial conditions (working capital) remained positive at 11.0, 10.6, and 6.5 index points, respectively. Respondents outlook on access to credit was however negative at -0.2 points. Respondents' are also optimistic on the volume of business activity in August 2020 as the index stood at 50.9 points (Fig. 5).



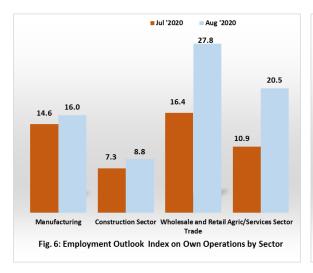
#### 3.3 Employment and Expansion Plans

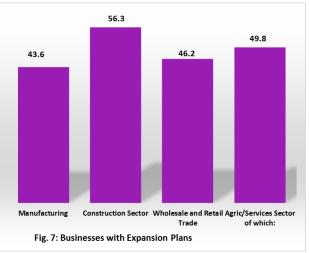
Respondent firms' opinions on the volume of business activities indicated a favourable business outlook for September and October 2020 with indices of 57.5 and 62.7 points, respectively. Businesses also hope to employ in September and October as the index was positive at 19.3 and 21.3 points, respectively.

The break down by sector showed that wholesale/retail trade had the highest prospect for employment in September with an index of (27.8 points) followed by agric/services (20.5 points), and manufacturing sector sector with 16.0 points (Fig. 6, Table 1).

Respondents were also optimistic about the volume of business activity and employment outlook index in the next 6 months as all indexes were positive.

The analysis of businesses with expansion plans in September showed that the construction sector indicates the highest disposition to expand with 56.3 index points. The agric./services sector had an index of 49.8 points, wholesale and retail sector had an index of 46.2 and manufacturing sector had 43.6 index points (Fig. 7, Table 1).



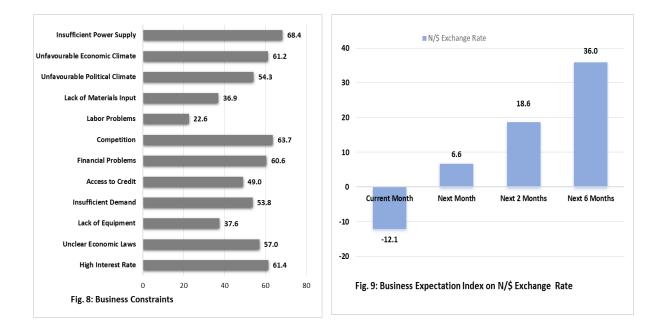


#### 3.4 Business Constraints

Respondent firms identified insufficient power supply (68.4 points), competition (63.7), high interest rates (61.4), unfavourable economic climate (61.2 points), financial problems (60.6 points), unclear economic laws (57.0 points), unfavourable political climate (54.3 points), insufficient demand (53.8 points), access to credit (49.0 points) and lack of equipment (37.6 points) as major factors constraining business activity in the current month (Fig. 8, Table 1).

### 3.5 Expectations on Exchange Rate

Respondent firms expect the naira to depreciate in August (-12.1 points) but to appreciate in the next month (6.6 points), next 2 months (18.6 points) and next 6 months (36.0 points). (Fig. 9, Table1).

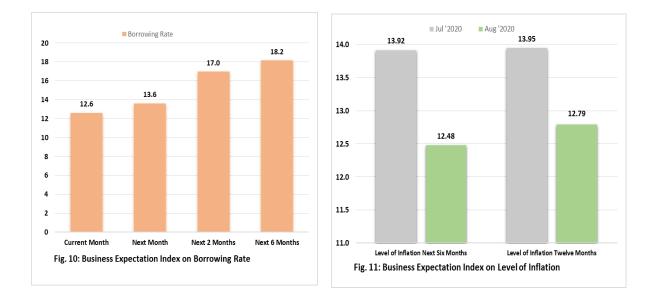


#### 3.6 Expectations on Borrowing Rates

Respondent firms expect borrowing rates to rise in the current month (12.6 points), next month (13.6 points), next 2 month (17.0 points) and the next 6 month (18.2 points) (Fig. 10, Table 1).

### 3.7 Expectations on Level of Inflation

Firms expect the average inflation rate in the next six months and the next twelve months to stand at 12.48 and 12.79 percent, respectively (Fig. 11, Table 1).



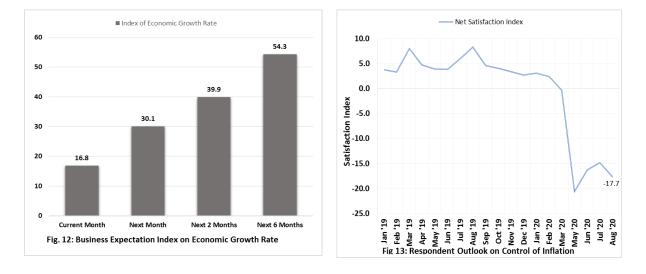
#### 3.8 Expectations on Economic Growth Rate

Respondents anticipate better economic conditions as the index on economic growth rate in the short run stood at 16.8 and 30.1 points for the current month and next month, respectively. They also anticipate improved economic conditions for the next 2 months and next 6 months as their index stood at 39.9 and 54.3 points, respectively (Fig. 12, Table 1).

#### 3.9 Opinion on Control of Inflation

Respondent firms expressed dissatisfaction with the management of inflation by the Government, with a negative net satisfaction index of -17.7 in August 2020.

The net satisfaction index is the proportion of satisfied less the proportion of dissatisfied respondents (Fig. 13,Table 1).
