# **PURCHASING MANAGERS' INDEX (PMI) MAY 2019 REPORT**

#### 1.0 Introduction

The May 2019 PMI survey was conducted by the Statistics Department of the Central Bank of Nigeria during the period May 6-10, 2019. The respondents were purchasing and supply executives of manufacturing and non-manufacturing organizations in all 36 states in Nigeria and the Federal Capital Territory (FCT). The Bank makes no representation regarding the individual companies, other than the information they have provided. The data contained herein further provides input for policy decisions.


### 1.1 Data and Method of Presentation

The Manufacturing and Non-Manufacturing PMI Report on businesses is based on survey responses, indicating the *changes* in the level of business activities in the *current month* compared with the preceding month. For each of the indicators measured, this report shows the diffusion index of the responses. The diffusion index is computed as the percentage of responses with positive change plus half of the percentage of those reporting no change, except for supplier delivery time, which is computed as the percentage of *responses with negative change plus half* of the percentage of those reporting no change. The composite PMI for the manufacturing sector is computed as the weighted average of five diffusion indices, namely: production level, level of new orders, suppliers' delivery time, employment level and raw materials inventory/work in progress, with assigned weights of 25%, 30%, 15%, 10% and 20%, respectively. The composite PMI for the non-manufacturing sector is computed from four diffusion indices, namely: business activity, level of new orders, employment level and raw materials inventory, with equal weights of 25% each.

A composite PMI above 50 points indicates that the manufacturing/non-manufacturing economy is generally expanding, 50 points indicates no change and below 50 points indicates that it is generally contracting. The subsectors reporting growth are listed in the order of highest to lowest growth, while those reporting contraction are listed in the order of the highest to the lowest contraction.

#### 2.0 Manufacturing PMI Report

Production level, supplier delivery time and employment level grew at a faster rate, while new orders and raw materials grew at a slower rate in May 2019




The Manufacturing PMI in the month of May stood at 57.8 index points, indicating expansion in the manufacturing sector for the twenty-sixth consecutive month (Fig. 2 and Table 1). The index grew at a faster rate when compared to the index in the previous month. Thirteen of the 14 subsectors surveyed reported growth in the review month in the following order: transportation equipment; electrical equipment; petroleum & coal products; paper products; cement; food, beverage & tobacco products; plastics & rubber products; chemical & pharmaceutical products; fabricated metal products; furniture & related products; nonmetallic mineral products; textile, apparel, leather & footwear and printing & related support activities. The primary metal subsector recorded decline in the review period.


#### 2.1 Production Level


At 59.1 points, the production level index for the manufacturing sector grew for the twenty-seventh consecutive month in May 2019. The index indicated a faster growth in the current month, when compared to its level in the month of April 2019. Eleven of the 14 manufacturing subsectors recorded increased production level, while 3 recorded decline (Fig. 3 and Table 2).

#### 2.2 New Orders

At 56.9 points, the new orders index grew for the twenty-sixth consecutive month, indicating increase in new orders in May 2019. Eight subsectors reported growth, 1 remained unchanged, while 5 contracted in the review month (Fig. 4 and Table 3).







#### 2.3 Supplier Delivery Time


The manufacturing supplier delivery time index stood at 58.4 points in May 2019, indicating faster supplier delivery time. The index has recorded growth for twenty-four consecutive months. Twelve of the 14 subsectors recorded improved suppliers' delivery time, while 1 remained unchanged and 1 recorded decline in the review period (Fig. 5 and Table 4).

# 2.4 Employment Level


The employment level index for May 2019 stood at 57.3 points, indicating growth in employment level for the twenty-fifth consecutive month. Of the 14 subsectors, 11 reported increased employment level, 1 reported unchanged employment level while 2 reported decreased employment in the review month (Fig. 6 and Table 5).

#### 2.5 Raw material Inventories

The Manufacturing sector inventories index grew for the twenty-sixth consecutive month in May 2019. At 56.8 points, the index grew at a slower rate when compared to its level in April 2019. Seven of the 14 subsectors recorded growth, 5 remain unchanged, while 2 sectors reported declined raw material inventories in the review month (Fig. 7 and Table 6).








### 3.0 Non-Manufacturing PMI Report


Business activity and inventories grew at a faster rate, while New orders and employment level grew at a slower rate in May 2019


The composite PMI for the nonmanufacturing sector stood at 58.9 points in May 2019, indicating expansion in the Non-manufacturing PMI for the twenty-fifth consecutive month. The index grew at a faster rate when compared to its level in April 2019. Sixteen of the 17 surveyed subsectors recorded growth in the following order: management of companies; entertainment & recreation; repair, maintenance/washing of motor vehicles; information & communication; agriculture; construction; educational services; real estate rental & leasing; electricity, gas, steam & air conditioning supply; health care & social assistance; wholesale/retail trade; accommodation & food services; finance & insurance; utilities; water supply, sewage & waste management and professional, scientific, & technical services. The transportation & warehousing recorded decline in the review period. (Fig. 9 and Table 7).

#### 3.1 Business Activity

At 59.2 points, the business activity index grew for the twenty-sixth consecutive month, indicating expansion in non-manufacturing business activity in May 2019. Fifteen subsectors recorded growth in business activity, 1 remained unchanged while 1 subsector recorded decline in the review month (Fig 10 Table 8).









#### 3.2 New Orders

At 58.6 points, new orders index grew for the twenty-sixth consecutive month in May 2019. All the 17 surveyed subsectors recorded growth in new orders in the review month (Fig 11 Table 9).




# 3.3 Employment Level

The employment level Index for the non-manufacturing sector stood at 58.5 points, indicating growth employment for the twenty-fifth consecutive month. Thirteen subsectors recorded growth employment level, 2 remained unchanged, while 2 subsector declined in the review period (Fig 12 Table 10).



# 3.4 Non-manufacturing Inventory

At 59.3 points, non-manufacturing inventory index grew for the twenty-fifth consecutive month, indicating growth in inventories in the review period. Of the seventeen surveyed subsectors, 13 recorded higher inventories, while 4 recorded unchanged inventories in May 2019 (Fig 13, Table 11).
