GOVERNOR SOLUDO REDEPLOYS DEPARTMENTAL DIRECTORS FOR A BETTER CBN

The Governor of the Central Bank of Nigeria, Professor Charles Soludo today announced the redeployment of departmental directors to fill the new 17 departmental structure of the Bank. In the redeployment, eight directors retained their old portfolios, while nine were posted to new departments.

The Governor while addressing the directors at their monthly meeting at the CBN Corporate Headquarters in Abuja reminded them that the exercise is a continuous one, because they will be appraised after a few months to ensure that indeed round pegs are in round holes. He further stated that the redeployed directors will be watched to see how the new team works to actualize the vision and mission of the new Central Bank of Nigeria in terms of efficiency, effectiveness, professionalism and accountability.

Professor Soludo urged the directors to work and create a Bank that will better serve Nigeria and the economy. He told them that he has tried to form a structure that is heavily weighted to address the core mandate of the CBN, away from the erstwhile leanage to noncore functions.

Professor Soludo advised those concerned in the new alighment not to see the restructuring from an individual prism of narrow interest. He cautioned the directors and the staff to see their work in the CBN as a call to national service and urged them not to engage in cheap blackmail which some of them are known for, because it would not work, if we must move the nation forward.

The redeployment of directors is with effect from today.
